Information Letter regarding Regulation (EU) 2024/3190 Restrictions on Bisphenols in Food Contact Materials

Dear business partners,

We would like to inform you about **Regulation (EU) 2024/3190**, which has been in effect since **January 20, 2025**, and which severely restricts or prohibits the use of **bisphenol A (BPA)** as well as other **bisphenols and bisphenol derivatives** in **food contact materials** within the European Union.

The regulation prohibits the use of these substances in food contact materials if they have a harmonized hazard classification.

This applies, among other things, to:

- Bisphenol A (BPA)
- Bisphenol AF
- Bisphenol S
- Bisphenol F
- other bisphenol derivatives

Some of our **FKM grades** use bisphenol-based crosslinking agents and may therefore be subject to the restrictions of the regulation.

During the vulcanization process, the cross-linking agent reacts chemically and breaks down to cross-link the rubber. Although the substance is theoretically completely consumed upon full curing, minor residues may remain in the final product.

According to the information provided by our material suppliers, all other materials we offer do not contain bisphenols and are not subject to the restrictions mentioned.

The specific materials affected are listed in our **current REACH compliance statement on our website**.

We are providing this information as a supplement to our REACH notices to ensure that you can fully and transparently understand the current European legal situation.
